Please examine a literature review for a topic of interest to you. Identify the following characteristics. Be sure to use the corresponding numbers to label at least one instance on the copy you turn in.

1. Identify the title.
2. Identify the author(s).
3. Identify the institutional affiliation for each author.
4. Label the information you would use to communicate with the author(s) of the paper if you wanted to learn more information.
5. Locate the abstract.
6. Identify a level one heading
7. Identify a level two heading.
8. Used multiple references for a single point. (find two instances)
9. Used the author name(s) in a sentence. (find two instances)
10. Used an (author, date) citation. (find two instances)
11. Locate the references section.
12. Label a citation that is of an article from a journal.
13. Label a citation that is of an edited book.
14. Count the total references listed.
15. Write a paragraph identifying the most important thing you learned from this article as it pertains to the project you are doing for this class.
